The greeting cards are packaged in an EarthFirst® PLA film, a compostable plastic wrap material made from corn. The packaging is printed on 100% recycled paper, which in turn can be recycled. The cards are made from 100% tree-free paper, handmade from recycled cotton rag scraps. Both the cards and packaging are printed with non-toxic vegetable based ink.

"We aim to have the highest standards in all aspects of our business, and will continue to look for ways to improve and be as Earth-friendly as possible," comments Evan Goldsmith, President of Hope For Women. "Our commitment to environmental sustainability builds upon our founding commitment to provide economic sustainability to the artisan women who handcraft the cards in India."

Goldsmith developed Hope

For Women after working with economically-disadvantaged artisan women in India, and founded the company to market their high-quality products and provide stable employment.

Hope For Women currently carries four collection lines of handmade greeting cards, each handcrafted using hand-pressed flowers, herbs, and grasses grown using organic farming methods or sustainably har-
